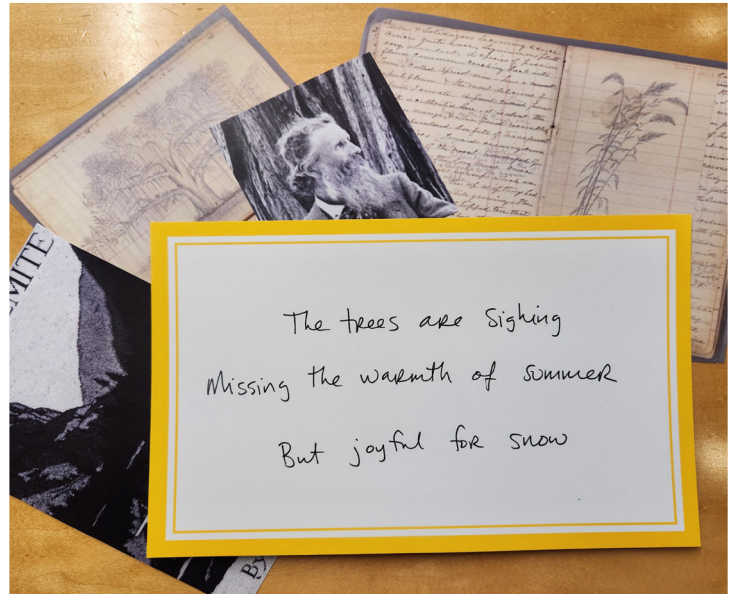
GAME WARDEN

In 1890, naturalist John Muir established the first National Parks in the state of California and became one of America's first game wardens. Muir is also known as an environmental philosopher and author, and for his advocacy on preservation of wilderness areas.
