Putting on the Ritz at Museum of Glass

Celebrate the Opening of *Art Deco Glass from the Huchthausen Collection* with a Swanky Cocktail Party on Friday, November 18

Tacoma, Wash. — Museum of Glass (MOG) members and the general public are invited to celebrate the opening of the Museum's newest exhibition, *Art Deco Glass from the Huchthausen Collection*, with a 1920s-style party on November 18 from 7 to 10 pm.

Art Deco Glass from the Huchthausen Collection includes over 200 Art Deco works in glass from the collection of artist David Huchthausen. The exhibition features early 20th century glass by iconic Art Deco studios such as René Lalique, Daum Frères, Pierre d'Avesn, Charles Schneider, Muller Frères, Marius-Ernest Sabino, Steuben Glass Works, and many others.

Museum member tickets are \$25 per person; general public tickets are \$35 tickets per person. Each ticket includes two complimentary drinks, hors d'oeuvres, and collector led tours of the exhibition. Guests are encouraged to come dressed in 1920s or cocktail attire.

Museum and Store open Wednesday through Saturday 10 am to 5 pm, Third Thursdays 10 am to 8 pm, and Sundays 12 pm to 5 pm until Memorial Day. Closed Monday and Tuesday. Closed Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day. Open Martin Luther King, Jr. Day and Presidents' Day. Museum and Store open Monday through Sunday during Summer months, Memorial Day through Labor Day. Open Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day.

Admission is free for members, \$15 general, \$12 seniors, military and students (13+ with ID), \$13 AAA Members, \$12 groups of 20 or more, \$10 groups of 50 or more, and \$5 for children (6-12) years old. Children 5 and under are admitted free. Admission is free every third Thursday of the month from 5 pm to 8 pm.
